1. MEDICAL:

2. LEGAL:

Legal guidance is central in providing access to justice by ensuring equality before the law. Our Legal team will consist of attorneys who specialize in different practice area, who can guide our community members and provide free of cost services to members who cannot afford the attorney fees.

3. FINAL RITES:

Last rites are an integral part of our funeral traditions. When there is a death in the family, relatives face not only emotional grief but also many issues coordinating Final Rites services for their lost loved one. Our team will help the grieving family in all possible ways to ensure raditions are adhered to and members can grieve their family member.

4. MATRIMONIAL:

The goal of marriage is to create a blissful union between a couple and foster love for the entire family, which keeps the family happily united. Our team will organize Meet and Greet events for our youth on a regular basis to create an environment for our singles to interact with like minded and similar background individuals.

5. YOUTH WING:

Sports are a crucial part of a youth's growth and development. We will encourage our youth to participate in Sports like Kabaddi and Cricket. APS will organize tournaments to encourage interplay between our youth.

6. CREATE AWARENESS ABOUT PUNJABI CULTURE AND PEOPLE:

While Punjabis are known for our strong values, our culture presents a multi-hued heritage of ancient civilizations. We will arrange seminars, lectures, public meetings to educate the mainstream Americans about Punjabi Arts, Culture, and the most crucial aspect of being a Punjabi, our faith and religion which emphasizes (1) Service to the community; (2) Equality and Respect amongst all humans; (3) Peaceful Living; and (4) Seva - defined as “selfless service” without any personal gain.

7. FUTURE PLANS:

By offering social, educational, and wellness programs, Community Centers contribute to enhancing the quality of life for community residents. Our future plan is to build a Community Center with a main hall and several smaller halls where community functions can take place. The Halls can be used for weddings, social events like Diwali and Vaisakhi. Smaller Halls can be used by our members, elders to do get-togethers. We will have a Library as well.







I wish the Society and the community members engaged with it the very best. We continue to count on their support for our community outreach and activities.





Punjab is known for its colorful celebrations and festivals, including Vaisakhi, which marks the harvest season's arrival and is the day Guru Gobind Singh established the Khalsa. and is celebrated with great enthusiasm by the Punjabi people. Lohri is a winter festival that marks the end of winter and brings people together around bonfires, singing and dancing in delight.

Other important religious festivals include Bandi Chhor Divas (Diwali) and Gurpurab which commemorates the birth anniversaries of Sikh Gurus.



social characteristics, with langars (Community Kitchens) set up in Gurudwaras (Sikh places of worship) providing free meals to people from all backgrounds 24/7.




The partitions of Punjab had a profound impact on Punjab and its people. Pre-partitioned Punjab Ruled by Maharaja Ranjit Singh included: Delhi, Jalandhar, Lahore, Multan, and Rawalpindi. As you can see in the image, Punjabi was a vast 100,436 square-kilometer empire.




In 1947 the region was divided along religious lines, leading to mass migration of people. The 1947 partition of the Subcontinent divided Punjab into two parts; West Punjab, belonging to Pakistan, and East Punjab, which became part of India. The state of Punjab is divided into four geographical regions, named the Majha, Doaba,

Malwa, and Puadh regions. Majha is the region between the rivers Ravi and Beas. The Doaba region is between Beas and Sutlej. Malwa lies below the river Sutlej and extends to the Yamuna River, and some parts of the Puadh region are a part of the Malwa region.



After the 1947 Partition, Punjab was then again divided. In 1966, the then Prime Minister of India, Indira Gandhi, announced the creation of a separate state for the hilly regions of Punjab, which later became Himachal Pradesh and Haryana. This was done to better address the unique social, economic, and cultural needs of the people in these hilly regions.



Punjab, with its diverse history and vibrant traditions, is a multi-layered and complex area of cultural wonders. Starting from the ancient civilizations to the Sikh legacy, Punjab's past has shaped its present. The Punjabis continue to celebrate their rich heritage through multiple different festivals.
